


Malvern Central School Foundation Information Night

Practise using and eating out of a lunch box

Practise using public toilets

Walk past or visit the school often

- Call or email if you have questions

Important Admin

FIRST AID - Medication

- Any medication must be brought in on the first day of school when a medication box will be made up for the specific student
- If Asthma or Anaphylaxis a Doctor's Action Plan must also be provided. These must be renewed annually.
- These medication boxes are kept in the staffroom for easy accessibility for all staff and specialists when students attend classes on the Spring Road campus.
- Medication must NOT be kept on the student or in their school bags

Does your child see a therapist or have a diagnoses?

- Email the school to organise a time to meet prior to the start of school.
- Provide reports from any specialist your child has seen.
